Why the Data Management Engagement Award?

Goal: new ideas for engaging researchers in good Research Data Management



What is the award?

- £1750 to bring the winning idea to life
 - Ideas that require more than £1,750 are eligible, but additional funding sources need to be identified



What are the selection criteria?

- applicable and transferable to a range of countries, institutions, settings and disciplines
- potential for wide impact — to engage with as many people as possible
- easily re-usable
- value for money

What are the selection criteria?

- feasibility (25%)
- impact (25%)
- transferability (25%)
- value for money (25%)



What are the rules?

Openness at the core:

- Submissions and evaluations (assessments) will be made public
- Learnings from the project will be published openly - free to access and re-use by anyone for any purpose

How to apply?

- 2 page outline of the idea
 - Plus: timeline & budget
- Send submissions to info@sparceurope.org
- Deadline: **28 February 2018**
- What's next?
 - Evaluations: first quarter of 2018
 - Work to be started by 30 July 2018
