- What is the problem?
 - We need metrics to evaluate the impact of data
 - Metrics are very prone to being gamed – need the right type!
 - Can't just shoe-horn data into “article-shaped” box

- Who is impacted (specific domains, professions, etc.)?
 - Aiming predominantly at researchers – method to encourage data openness
 - Also funders, research institutes, publishers

- What are the ramifications of not having the problem resolved?
 - No rewards for data sharing/good data stewardship
 - Proliferation of different metrics, no standardisation or agreement on what they mean

- Working Group structure
 - 52 members, mostly European, USA
 - Mixture of academics, repository managers, academic publishers

- “Next steps for Bibliometrics for Data” will be based on:
 - WG survey results (presented P4 and P5)
 - Spreadsheet of metrics being collected by repositories - Still open for contributions! <http://bit.ly/1MpyW4K>
 - Shared results from other projects – understanding the challenges and answering the questions posed in the case statement
 - Preliminary analysis of data DOI resolutions
 - Supporting and evaluating tools from other projects
 - Preliminary guidance for the community - “minimal” rather than “best” practice – get people discussing the issues and coming up with solutions!
