Title of the Meeting: Preparation of a WG Case Statement

Introduction

Research data are stored in a wide variety of repository platforms, using disparate data modeling and metadata standards, file formats, and conventions. In the complex lifecycle of a research data object it will be necessary to migrate or share data between repository platforms. Currently there exists nearly no "exchange standard" or interoperability between different repository platforms making migration of research data objects difficult to impossible.

The Research Data Repository Interoperability Working Group plans to establish consensus for an interoperability specification of research data repository platforms. This may include (but is not limited to) a generic API and import/export formats.

Due to its scope this WG ideally fosters relations to a number of RDA WGs and IGs that may be able to contribute with their results to or benefit from this WG's work, e.g. Repository Platforms for Research Data, Data Fabric IG, Data Description Registry Interoperability WG, Data Type Registries WG.
