from 111 countries

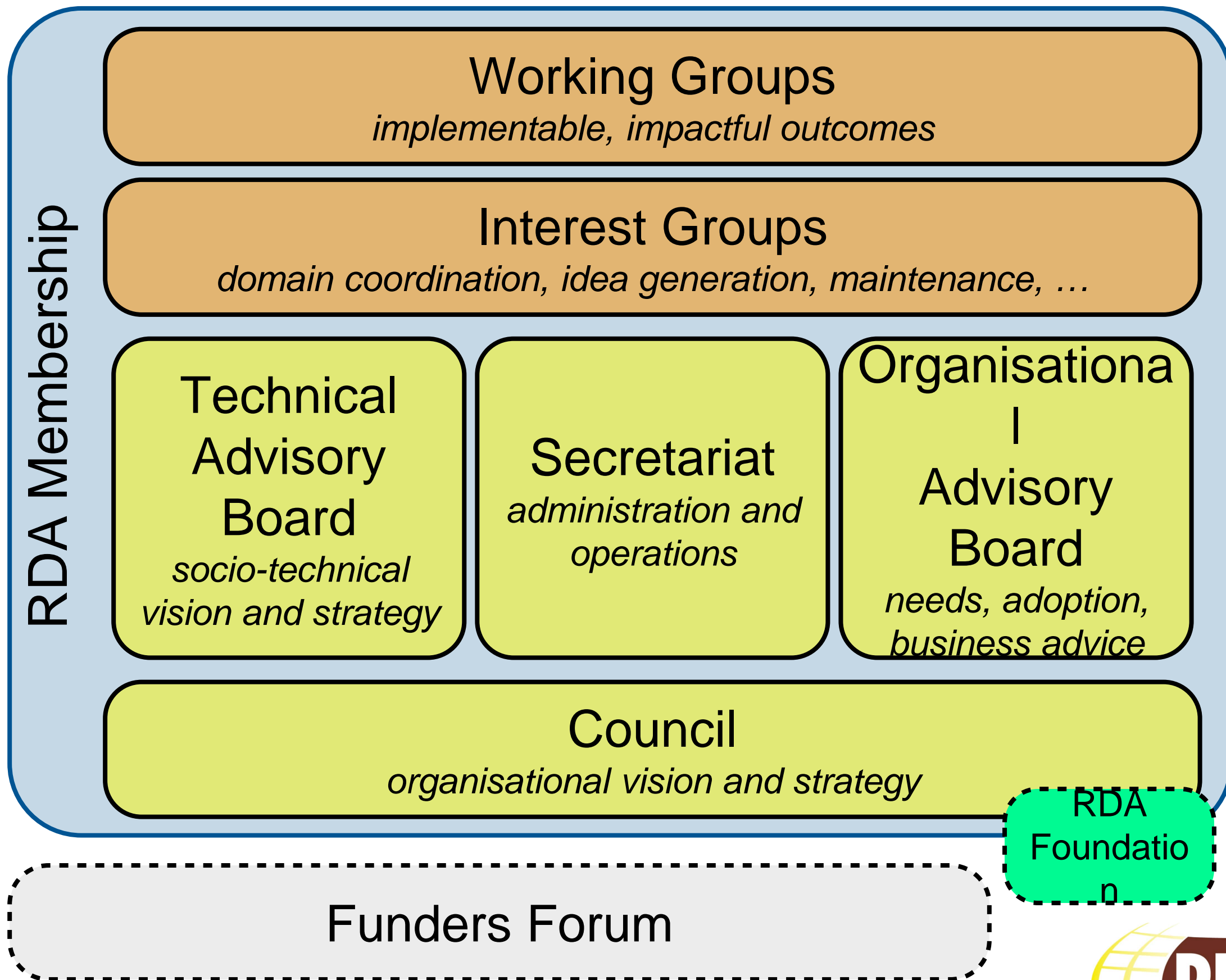

Some themes amidst the difference

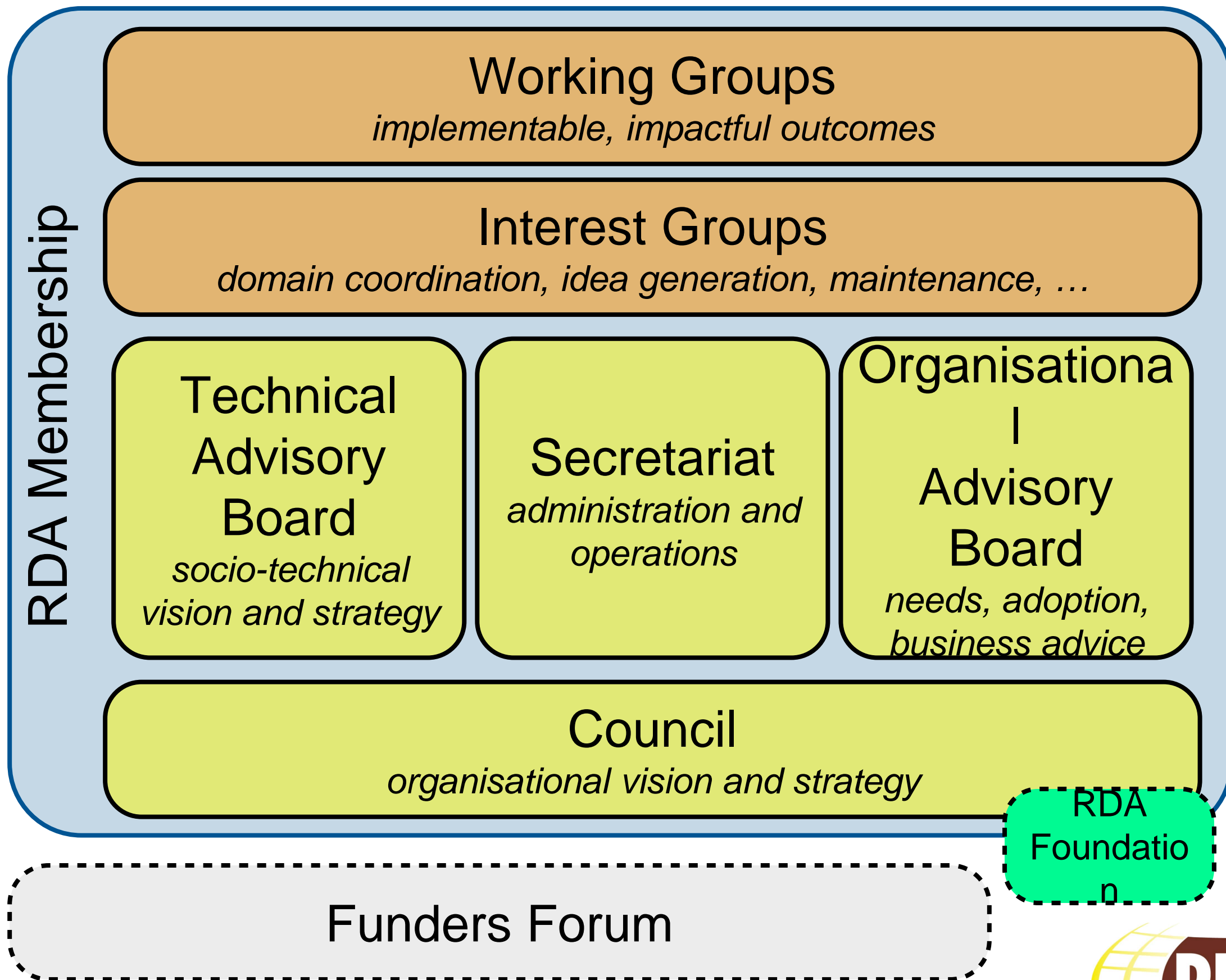
1. **Persistent Identifiers** for data, documents, people, organisations, instruments—Everything!
